The Project - The Combat Paper Project provides veterans the opportunity to participate in a free, five-day workshop that assists them in reconciling and sharing their personal military experiences through art-making techniques historically rooted in the process of hand papermaking. The workshop is open to veterans and family members of veterans from Wake Tech and the local community.

The Workshop - Wake Technical Community College is sponsoring this week long event which is limited to 20 participants. Workshop participants will transform uniforms or other articles of clothing into paper pulp, then create unique works of paper art from the pulp. These sheets of paper serve as the basis for journals, prints, pulp paintings and as a medium for personal images or stories.

Combat Paper Project - is a group of experienced facilitators, both veterans and visual artists, who have been teaching workshops around the country since 2008. They have visited a number of college campuses here in the United States as well as in Canada and the U.K.
